Title of the Practice: NOON MEALS SCHEME

Objectives:

- > To satisfies the hunger and ensuring nutritious growth to needy students
- > To eradicate poverty and monetary inequality within campus
- To create an amiable atmosphere for financially backward students to pursue education
- > to increase in literacy rate of students.

The Context:

Many students at Pope's College, particularly those from rural backgrounds, face the daily struggle of food insecurity. The challenge of providing support was compounded by the students' reluctance to openly acknowledge their financial difficulties. They were hesitant to participate in traditional aid programs that required public disclosure. To address this sensitive issue, the college devised a discreet and confidential approach. By understanding the students' desire for privacy, the college developed a support system that ensures they receive necessary assistance without compromising their dignity. This innovative solution empowers students to focus on their studies, knowing that their well-being is being cared for.

The Practice:

The success of the Noon Meals Scheme hinges on the dedicated efforts of the Coordinator. They play a crucial role in ensuring the smooth operation of the program. At the beginning of each academic year, students are discreetly informed about the scheme through their tutors. Tutors then liaise with the Coordinator to identify students in need, ensuring confidentiality throughout the process. The Coordinator issues tokens to these students, which they can redeem for daily meals at the college canteen. This token system guarantees equitable distribution and anonymity, safeguarding the dignity of the beneficiaries. Approximately 44 students were supported by the scheme in the 2023-2024 academic year. The financial burden of the program is shared by the dedicated staff of the aided stream, who make monthly contributions. The Coordinator meticulously maintains records of these contributions and expenditures. A sample of a monthly financial statement is provided below.

Evidence of Success:

Beneficiaries of the Noon Meals Scheme express their gratitude to the Coordinator and their respective departments. They appreciate the opportunity to have a nutritious meal at the college, contributing to their overall well-being. The quality of the food is a top priority. The Coordinator and staff regularly monitor the meals to ensure they meet nutritional standards. Additionally, a dedicated WhatsApp group has been established to gather direct feedback from students. Their input regarding the quality and quantity of the meals is valued and used to continually improve the program.
