### DATA COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS

Curricula Analysis is a process utilized by our college to solicit information from a variety of sources on different aspects of the curriculum. Most often, information solicited in this feedback process includes feedback from all the stakeholders of the College. The IQAC of the college has developed the online feedback mechanism (Structured rating based Google forms) and obtaining feedback from various stakeholders.




The IQAC of the college collects feedback form from the students, teachers, alumni and parents pertaining to the varied aspects of the curriculum they studied for continuous improvement in curriculum development and enrichment. The feedback forms have been designed with the help of Google forms and shared with the stakeholders through social media groups. They are required to submit their responses to a set of ten statements ona5-point Likert Scale in which choices range from Strongly Disagree(1) to Strongly Agree(5) and 2-point Likert Scale (Yes or No).

In order to arrive to comprehensive results useful statistical tool percentage have been used. The feedback thus received is then analysed. The analysis of the stakeholders' feedback for the session 2021-2022, is presented as Stakeholders-wise and is as follows:

# STUDENTS FEEDBACK ON CURRICULA 2021 - 2022 Students Profile





The students are the most important stakeholders of Higher Education systems. The interest and participation of students at all levels in both internal quality assurance and external quality assurance have to play a central role. We have collected online feedback from our under graduate students and post graduate students. We have received total 627 student's online feedback on the curriculum of the various programmes designed by the college. The above chart shows that 59.8% of respondents were girls and 40.2% were boys.




The above Chart depicts the course wise classification of student respondents. It was noticed that 17.7% responses were received from Maths department students, 17.4% from Economics department students, 13.4% from Zoology students, 11% responses from Physics students, 10.8% responses were collected from Tamil students, 9.9% responses were collected from commerce students and 8.1% responses were collected from English students. The remaining percentage of responses were Chemistry students.


### CHARTS SHOWING THE STUDENTS RESPONSES ON CURRICULA 2021 - 2022









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


### **TEACHERS FEEDBACK ON CURRICULA 2021-2022**

Teacher profile data was collected by sending Google form to faculties of various courses total 37 responses have been collected from the teachers, the above chart


shows that 89.1% were Assistant Professors and 10.81% were Associate Professors The received 37 teachers' feedback regarding curriculum were analysed.





\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\* The above Chart depicts the course wise classification of teacher respondents. \*It was noticed that 18.92% responses were received from Tamil department teachers, 16.21% from Commerce and Economic teachers, 10.8% from Maths department teachers, 8.10% responses from Chemistry teachers, and 5.4% responses were collected from Computer science, Physics and Zoology and 2.7% responses were collected from Botany, English, History and Fashion designing teachers.


## PARENTS FEEDBACK ON CURRICULA 2021 - 2022




#### Alumni Profile






### CHARTS SHOWING THE ALUMNI RESPONSES ON CURRICULA 2021-2022





