He emphasized, after modernism there is a conflict between science v/s traditions, machine v/s moral. Science affects the environment, so we need to look back to our traditions and identity. Finally he highlighted the postmodernism has lot of demerits and we need to bring back the glory of God. Feedback was given by the participants of various Departments. Totally 25 students of UG and PG students of BBA, Zoology and Chemistry Departments were benefitted.

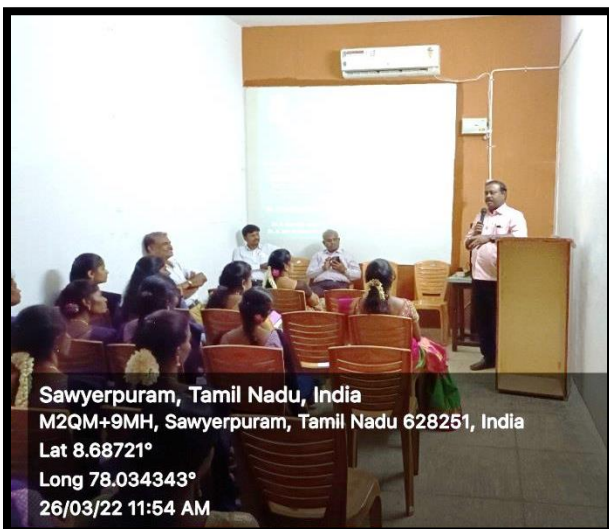
